The Ghost	dead King of Denmark, Hamlet's father; calls upon Hamlet to avenge him
Hamlet	the Prince of Denmark, full of bitterness and hatred, seeks to avenge his father's death
Queen Gertrude	Hamlet's mother- a shallow, weak woman who cares more about status than what's right
King Claudius	Hamlet's uncle who marries Gertrude, the current king of Denmark; the play's villain
Ophelia	Hamlet's love interest; a sweet and innocent young woman dependent on men to tell her how to behave
Laertes	Ophelia's brother; passionate and quick to action; Hamlet's foil
Polonius	Pompous, conniving man; father to Ophelia and Laertes
Horatio	Hamlet's closest friend, a loyal and helpful man
Rosencrantz & Guildenstern	Fellow classmates of Hamlet's; sent by the king and queen to find out what's wrong with Hamlet
