There are more than **80** variations recorded for the spelling of his name.

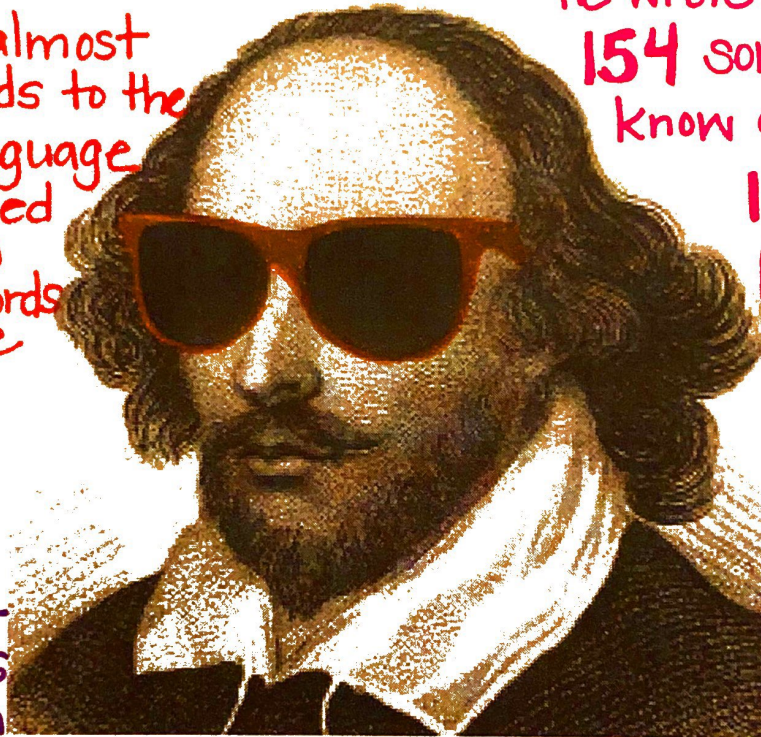
Had **7** siblings and **3** children
